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#### REV. FR. MESROB LAKISSIAN ATTENDES WAKE SERVICE FOR COUNCILMAN WALTER L. McCAFFREY



Walter L. McCaffrey 1949 – 2013

Rev. Fr. Mesrob Lakissian, pastor of St. Illuminator's Cathedral in New York City, attended the wake service for former Queens Councilman Walter McCaffrey, on July 14 at Edward Lynch Funeral Home in Sunnyside, Queens. Councilman McCaffrey was 64 years old.

He was first elected in 1985 and served for four terms representing the neighborhoods of Woodside, Long Island City, and Sunnyside for 16 years.

Der Mesrob noted that "Mr. McCaffrey was a good friend of the Armenian people. The Armenian community of New York will always remember him for his principled stance on the Armenian Genocide." The Councilman was instrumental in organizing annual April 24th commemorations at New York's City Hall.

## **BLESSING OF THE HOME**

Throughout the year, Armenian homes are blessed. They are blessed most often at Christmas and Easter. A family, moving into a new home, contacts the priest to come for a home blessing.

The family provides a slice of bread, a glass of water and a small dish of salt on a tray. These three things are known as life-giving gifts from God.

Priest comes to the home with incense, an incense burner and a wafer or nushkhar.

**The priest blesses the incense (khoong).** The burning incense and the smoke rising are our prayers on their way to God. In church, the priest and deacon use the censer (poorvar) to cense the congregation and holy objects.

**The priest blesses the bread (hatz).** We need bread to provide our bodies with nourishment. During the Badarak, we remember the Last Supper. We believe that the bread becomes the body of Jesus Christ.

The priest blesses the water (choor). Like bread, water is necessary for life. Water also reminds us of our own baptism in holy water.

**The priest blesses the salt (agh).** Salt provides flavor to our food. Jesus called his followers "the salt of the earth." Because each one of us is different, we can make the world a better place. Like adding salt, we can add our own special flavor to the world – our faith, our hope, our acts of kindness, our love for other people.

The priest asks God to continue to provide the family with the gifts of bread, water and salt. He also asks God to bless and keep the family and grant them good health. When the service is finished, the priest leaves the wafer (nushkhar) for the family. The family usually places the wafer in a jar of rice, flour, or lentils or other grain). This is done as a way of asking God to keep these grains always in supply for the family to use.

During these passed months Rev. Fr. Mesrob Lakissian blessed many homes of our parishioners.

# THIRD SUNDAY AFTER TRANSFIGURATION

#### THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MATTHEW (19:3-12)

Some Pharisees came to Jesus, and to test him they asked, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for any cause?" He answered, "Have you not read that the one who made them at the beginning 'made them male and female,' and said, 'For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let no one separate." They said to him, "Why then did Moses command us to give a certificate of dismissal and to divorce her?" He said to them, "It was because you were so hard-hearted that Moses allowed you to divorce your wives, but from the beginning it was not so. And I say to you, whoever divorces his wife, except for unchastely, and marry another commits adultery. His disciples said to him, "If such is the case of a man with his wife, it is better not to marry." But he said to them, "Not everyone can accept this teaching, but only those to whom it is given. For there are eunuchs who have been so from birth, and there are eunuchs who have been made eunuchs by others, and there are eunuchs who have made themselves eunuchs for the sake of the kingdom of heaven. Let anyone accept this who can."
