SAVING ARMENIAN MOTHER'S LIFE

Sevan Hajinian is a 52 year old mother of 15 and 17 year old daughters who needed a life-saving spine surgery at NYU Langone Medical Hospital for Joint Diseases.

Mrs. Hajinian and her brother are highly-dedicated members of the Canadian-Armenian community and active in the Canadian civil society. In addition to authoring an important resource book about "The Armenian Genocide Denied (A Response to Turkey's Thirteen Propaganda Spins)", she has been a volunteer youth leader, school board trustee, school parents committee member, and a social services, immigration and government relations adviser. Mrs. Hajinian had here surgery on Tuesday December 4. According to the doctors, the surgery went well. She was discharged from the hospital on December 15.

The initial estimated cost of the hospital and the doctors is US \$146.000. The Hajinian family, the Canadian Armenian Community, and their friends

from various faiths based and Canadian civil society organizations have raised CDN \$120.000. The hospital agreed to schedule the surgery with what they have raised so far on the condition that the remaining balance will be paid after the surgery. Already the family transferred US \$71,000 to the hospital. The doctors' fees of US \$48,500 have been paid in full. The family still have to pay the hospital's remaining fees.

The above cost is based on 5 hours of surgery room operation time and 5 days of hospitalization. The surgery lasted around 7:30 hours. Mrs. Hajinina's stayed in the hospital exceeded the 5 days. In total she stayed at the hospital almost two weeks.

Mrs. Hanjinian's case is high profile case in Canada and the media covered her story on TV, radio, and print.

So far St. Illuminator's Cathedral and community already raised \$4,000.00.

BLESSING OF THE HOMES

Throughout the year, Armenian homes are blessed. They are blessed most often at Christmas and Easter. A family, moving into a new home, contacts the priest to come for a home blessing.

The family provides a slice of bread, a glass of water and a small dish of salt on a tray. These three things are known as life-giving gifts from God.

Priest come to the home with incense, an incense burner and a wafer or nushkhar.



The priest blesses the incense (khoong). The burning incense and the smoke rising are our prayers on their way to God. In church, the priest and deacon use the censer (poorvar) to cense the congregation and holy objects.

The priest blesses the bread (hatz). We need bread to provide our bodies with nourishment. During the Badarak, we remember the Last Supper. We believe that the bread becomes the body of Jesus Christ.

The priest blesses the water (choor). Like bread, water is necessary for life. Water also reminds us of our own baptism in holy water.

The priest blesses the salt (agh). Salt provides flavor to our food. Jesus called his followers "the salt of the earth." Because each one of us is different, we can make the world a better place. Like adding salt, we can add our own special flavor to the world – our faith, our hope, our acts of kindness, our love for other people.

The priest asks God to continue to provide the family with the gifts of bread, water and salt. He also asks God to bless and keep the family and grant them good health. When the service is finished, the priest leaves the wafer (nushkhar) for the family. The family usually places the wafer in a jar of rice, flour, or lentils or other grain). This is done as a way of asking God to keep these grains always in supply for the family to use.

BLESSING OF THE WATER

The baptism of Jesus Christ is celebrated on the same day as Armenian Christmas, January 6. At the end of the Christmas Badarak, a special service is held to remember the baptism of Jesus Christ in the River Jordan. It is called Churorhnek (the Blessing of Water).

Water is poured into a bowl. A cross is placed in the water to remind us of the baptism of Jesus. Holy Oil (Muron) is poured into the water from a dove-shaped vessel to remind us that the Holy Spirit was sent by God and was present at the baptism. At the end of the service, the priest removes the cross from the water and gives it to a member of the congregation chosen as the godfather of the cross. The congregation comes forward to kiss the cross and to receive some of the Holy Water. They can drink the water or take it home.

NATIVITY OF JESUS CHRIST (THEOPHANY)

THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MATTHEW (1:18-25)

Now the birth of Jesus the Messiah took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been engaged to Joseph, but before they lived together she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. Her husband Joseph, being a righteous man and unwilling to expose her to public disgrace, planned to dismiss her quietly. But just when he had resolved to do this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife, for the child conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. She will bear a son, for he will save his people from their sins." 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
