HAMAZKAYIN OF NEW YORK SCREENS ZAREH TJEKNAVORIAN'S DOCUMENTARY FILM "ENEMY OF THE PEOPLE"

On Sunday, January 27, 2013, at 1:00 p.m., at the Pashalian Hall of St. Illuminator's Cathedral the New York chapter of Hamazkayin Educational and Cultural Society organized the screening of the documentary film "Enemy of the People: Armenians Look Back at the Stalin Terror" directed and produced by Zareh Tjeknavorian.

Dr. Ara Caprielian, chairman of Hamazkayin of New York, began the program with his welcoming remarks, during which he expressed his gratitude to Rev. Fr. Mesrob Lakissian for making the Pashalian Hall available gratis for such cultural events. Then, he introduced Zareh Tjeknavorian to the audience. Tjeknavorian was born in Fargo, ND, but grew up in a cosmopolitan international environment due to his father, composer and conductor Loris Tjeknavorian's tours in various countries. Zareh lived in San Francisco, Iran, London, Germany, Paris, New York City, and Armenia. He graduated from Tisch School of the Arts, New York University in 1992, with a bachelor's degree in film and television production.

"Enemy of the People," narrated by Eric Bogosian, is Tjeknavorian's most widely-known documentary film, which depicts Stalinist oppression in Armenia. In fact, National Geographic Magazine recommended it as one of three must-see films about Armenia, along with "The Color of Pomegranates" by Sergei Parajanov and "Ararat" by Atom Egoyan.

At the conclusion of the program, Dr. Ara Caprielian invited Fr. Mesrob Lakissian to the podium to make the closing remarks. Fr. Mesrob expressed his pleasure at seeing such a poignant film, congratulated Zareh Tjeknavorian on his accomplishment, and presented him with a beautifully crafted miniature replica of the Armenian Genocide Commemoration Monument erected in Antelias. He also praised Dr. Caprielian and the rest of the Hamazkayin board members for organizing this significant function. And, in response to Dr. Caprielian's expression of gratitude for making the Pashalian Hall available gratis for such events, Fr. Mesrob said, *"We renovated the Pashalian Hall for that very same purpose. Anytime you organize a cultural event, the hall is yours. This is also your cultural home."

VARTANANTZ



On Thursday, February 7, the Armenian Church commemorates Vartanantz—the war between pagan Persia and Christian Armenia in 451. The king of Persia ordered all Christians under his rule to abandon Christianity and embrace Mazdeism. The Armenian clergy and ruling princes refused to abandon their faith. As recorded by the historian Yeghishe, the soldiers took an oath to fight the enemies of truth: "We are ready for persecution and death and every affliction and torture for the sake of the holy churches which our forefathers entrusted to us by the power of the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, whereby we were reborn to the one hope of faith by baptism in Christ Jesus. In the same fashion we wish to renew ourselves by torments and blood. For we recognize the Holy Gospel as our Father, and the apostolic catholic church as Mother. Let no evil partition come between us to separate us from her."

The clergy supported the soldiers, and Yeghishe records the speech given on the priest Ghevond on the eve of the battle where he says, "You all know that in former times, when you went out to war you had the custom that priests would always be in the camp, and at the hour of battle, relying upon their prayers, you would leave them in a safe place. But today bishops, priests, and deacons, singers of the psalms and readers of Scripture, each in his own canonical rank, like armed men ready for battle, wish to attack with you and smite the enemies of the truth."

Vartan Mamigonian was the leader of the Armenians in the battle of Avarayr, and although outnumbered, the Armenians put up a valiant defense. Vartan and many of his soldiers were killed, but the Persians suffered greater casualties and with this battle they realized the strong commitment the Armenians had for their Christian faith.

The struggle against Persian rule continued for more than thirty years. In 484 Vahan Mamigonian, nephew of Vartan, successfully negotiated the Treaty of Nvarsag, the first document in history granting religious freedom and home rule.

Տօնին վերջին եւ հանդիսաւոր օրը, Յիսուս ոտքի կանգնած՝ բարձրաձայն կ՛ըսէր.-«Ով որ ծարաւ է՝ թող ինծի գայ եւ խմէ։ Ով որ ինծի կը հաւատայ, ինչպէս Սուրբ գիրքը կ՛ըսէ՝ «Անոր սիրտէն կենսատու ջուրի գետեր պիտի բղխին»։ Յիսուս ասիկա կ՛ըսէր Հոգիին համար, որ իրեն հաւատացողները պիտի ընդունէին. իսկ Հոգին տակաւին չէր տրուած, քանի Յիսուս փառաւորուած չէր։

Ժողովուրդէն ոմանք երբ լսեցին այս խօսքերը, ըսին. «Այս է ճշմարիտ մարգարէն»։ Ուրիշներ կ՛ըսէին. «Քրիստոսն է»։ Իսկ ոմանք ալ կ՛ըսէին. «Միթէ Գալիլեայէ՞ն պիտի գայ Քրիստոսը։ Սուրբ գիրքը չ՛ը՞սեր՝ թէ Քրիստոս Դաւիթ թագաւորի սերունդէն պիտի ըլլայ եւ Դաւիթի քաղաքին՝ Բեթլեհէմի մէջ պիտի ծնի»։ Եւ Յիսուսի պատճառով տարակարծութիւններ յառաջ եկան ժողովուրդին մէջ։ Ոմանք ուզեցին ձերբակալել զինք, բայց ոչ ոք համարձակեցաւ ձեռք զարնել։

Երբ տաճարին պահակները վերադարձան, աւագ քահանաներն ու Փարիսեցիները հարցուցին անոնց. «ինչո՞ւ զինք հոս չբերիք»։ Պահակները պատասխանեցին. «Այս մարդուն պէս խօսող երբեք չենք տեսած»։ Փարիսեցիները ըսին. «Ի՞նչ, դո՞ւք ալ խաբուեցաք։ Իշխանաւորներէն կամ Փարիսեցիներէն ոեւէ մէկը հաւատա՞ց անոր։ Մեր Օրէնքը չգիտցող տգէտ ամբոխը միայն հաւատաց։ Անոնք արդէն իսկ նզովուած են»։

Նիկոդեմոս, Փարիսեցիներէն մէկը, որ նախապէս գիշերով եկած էր Յիսուսի մօտ, ըսաւ անոնց. «Արդեօք մեր օրէնքը մարդս կը դատէ՞ նախ քան զինք լսելը եւ գիտնալը թէ ի՜նչ ըրած է»:

Անոնք պատասխանեցին Նիկոդեմոսի. «Միթէ դո՞ւն ալ Գալիլեայէն ես. քննէ Սուրբ գիրքերը եւ պիտի տեսնես, թէ Գալիլեայէն մարգարէ չ՜ելլեր»։

FOURTH SUNDAY AFTER NATIVITY

THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO JOHN (7:37-52)

On the last day of the festival, the great day, while Jesus was standing there, he cried out, "Let anyone who is thirsty come to me, and let the one who believes in me drink. As the scripture has said, 'Out of the believer's heart shall flow rivers of living water'." Now he said this about the Spirit, which believers in him were to receive, for as yet there was no Spirit, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

When they heard these words, some in the crowd said, "This is really the prophet." Others said, "This is the Messiah." But some asked, "Surely the Messiah does not come from Galilee, does he? Has not the scripture said that the Messiah is descended from David and comes from Bethlehem, the village where David lived?" So there was a division in the crowd because of him. Some of them wanted to arrest him, but no one laid hands on him.

Then the temple police went back to the chief priests and Pharisees, who asked them, "Why did you not arrest him?" The police answered, "Never has anyone spoken like this!" Then the Pharisees replied, "Surely you have not been deceived too, have you? Has any one of the authorities or of the Pharisees believed in him? But this crowd, which does not know the law – they are accursed." Nicodemus, who had gone to Jesus before, and who was one of them, asked, "Our law does not judge people without first giving them a hearing to find out what they are doing, does it?" They replied, "Surely you are not also from Galilee, are you? Search and you will see that no prophet is to arise from Galilee."
